

ORKHUN Academic Exchange Program

General information about the program

The Turkish Council is an international exchange program in which students who are members of the Turkish University Association and wish to study for one or two semesters per academic year at the following universities or teachers who wish to use mobility for a certain period of time.

Requirements for candidates



- * 2-3 undergraduate courses (students studying on a budget basis, as well as on a paid basis can participate);
- * Citizenship of the Republic of Kazakhstan;
- * High academic performance (average score must be higher than 3.0);
- * Fluency in a foreign language, certification (upper-intermediate and advanced);
- * Competitive selection at the faculty.

1. Questionnaire of a citizen of the Republic of Kazakhstan;
2. Transcript;
3. Certificate of foreign language proficiency B2 (IELTS, TOEFL);
4. Reference (form 082/086);
5. Copy of passport;
6. Figure -3/4;

Orkhon Exchange Program The Orkhon Exchange Program is regulated by the Association of Advisory Turkish Universities (TURKUNIB) and the Ahmet Yassawi University Exchange Program Directive.



*Information for students
who want to use the
orkhon exchange
program:*

1. There are no restrictions on sections in applications. Upon receipt of all applications, grades are made in accordance with the decision to admit students to the host university and the results are published. Our applicants should check to see if they have their own department / curriculum at the university website where they would like to apply.
2. Students studying in another country as international students will not benefit from the change.
3. The duration of student exchange includes at least one semester and at least two semesters. The semester report can be changed depending on the education system. However, the total duration of the shift should not exceed one academic year.
4. Training of students participating in official educational programs, first-year students and senior students can not apply for the exchange program.
5. The general academic average score for the application requires at least two and a half out of four points. (The grading system in response to the fourth grade calculated on the table is based on the decisions of the host universities.)
6. Students continue to pay contributions / tuition fees to educational institutions that are required to pay by registering at their higher education institutions when they are students of the Orkhon exchange program. Students participating in the exchange cannot cancel their entries. Also, students do not have to pay tuition fees to the university they are going to.
7. Students of the Orkhon exchange program may be subject to other financial obligations imposed on their students by higher education institutions. This issue is specified in the contract of the student of the Orkhon exchange program with the students admitted to the program. Institutions of higher education cannot offer additional financial requests to students of the Orkhon exchange program other than the financial October required of their students.
8. Other scholarships and loans received by students participating in the Orkhon exchange program continue.
